Jessie was a beautiful athletic, smart and compassionate girl who fought two brain tumors (DIPG) from March 3, 2011 to January 5, 2012. On that painful day, Jessie left and amazing legacy of love that her family foundation now continues.

During her 10 month courageous fight, Jessie focused on spreading hope, joy and love to other kids fighting cancer. She knew having cancer made kids feel lonely and limited, and as a result, Jessie felt empowered to help ease these feelings for those children fighting. Jessie shared her message to **NEGU** (**Never Ever Give Up**) to as many kids as she could. Believe it or not, summer is just around the corner and will be here at Geneva Children's Center before you know it!



# **Xtreme Dance and Martial Arts Classes Optional Programs Offered at GCC**





GCC offers optional programs to enhance your child's learning experience. Currently offered is the **Xtreme Dance Class**. Dance class meets Mondays, 3:30-4:30 and is available to all GCC students. At this time 15 GCC students now attend the Xtreme Dance and there is still space available. Class is \$60 per month. New Martial Arts class to be offered at GCC. Family Martial Arts Center, Inc. of Lake Forest is now offering a new class here at GCC. This 45 minute class meets twice a week. The class is \$110 per month and includes a uniform, a \$40 value. Class is offered on a month to month basis, no contracts. Ten students are required to enroll before the program can begin.
